

- The way we communicate with each other has changed.
- Far Right digital strategists understand this.
- Using the internet and social media, they have built powerful digital propaganda machines.
- The billionaires that own the infrastructure are a part of the problem.



Brad Parscale

- Helped build Cambridge Analytica
- Trump's 2016 digital director-turned mastermind of data-driven far-right campaigning.
- Built Campaign Nucleus, an all-in-one digital war machine for right-wing candidates.

- Social listening is the process of using technology to gather data across digital platforms and from data brokers.
- That data is then analyzed providing insights into users' behaviours, views, political connections.
- It is then used to manipulate people's emotions with tailored campaigns.


What we do at Jarnow Insights
