

Arthur Torrington CBE is a community advocate, and co-founder (**with the late Sam B. King MBE**) of Windrush Foundation which they first established in 1995 in London to commemorate the arrival of Caribbean men and women on Tuesday 22 June 1948 at Tilbury Docks, Essex, having travelled on the ship Empire Windrush. Through the Foundation, a registered charity, Arthur also promotes good race and community relations, and designs projects that publicises the contributions of African and Caribbean men and women who settled in the UK before and after 22 June 1948, especially those who served King and Country in WWI and WWII. Arthur chairs African Heritage Forum and The Equiano Society, both of which he co-founded in 1995 and 2011 respectively
