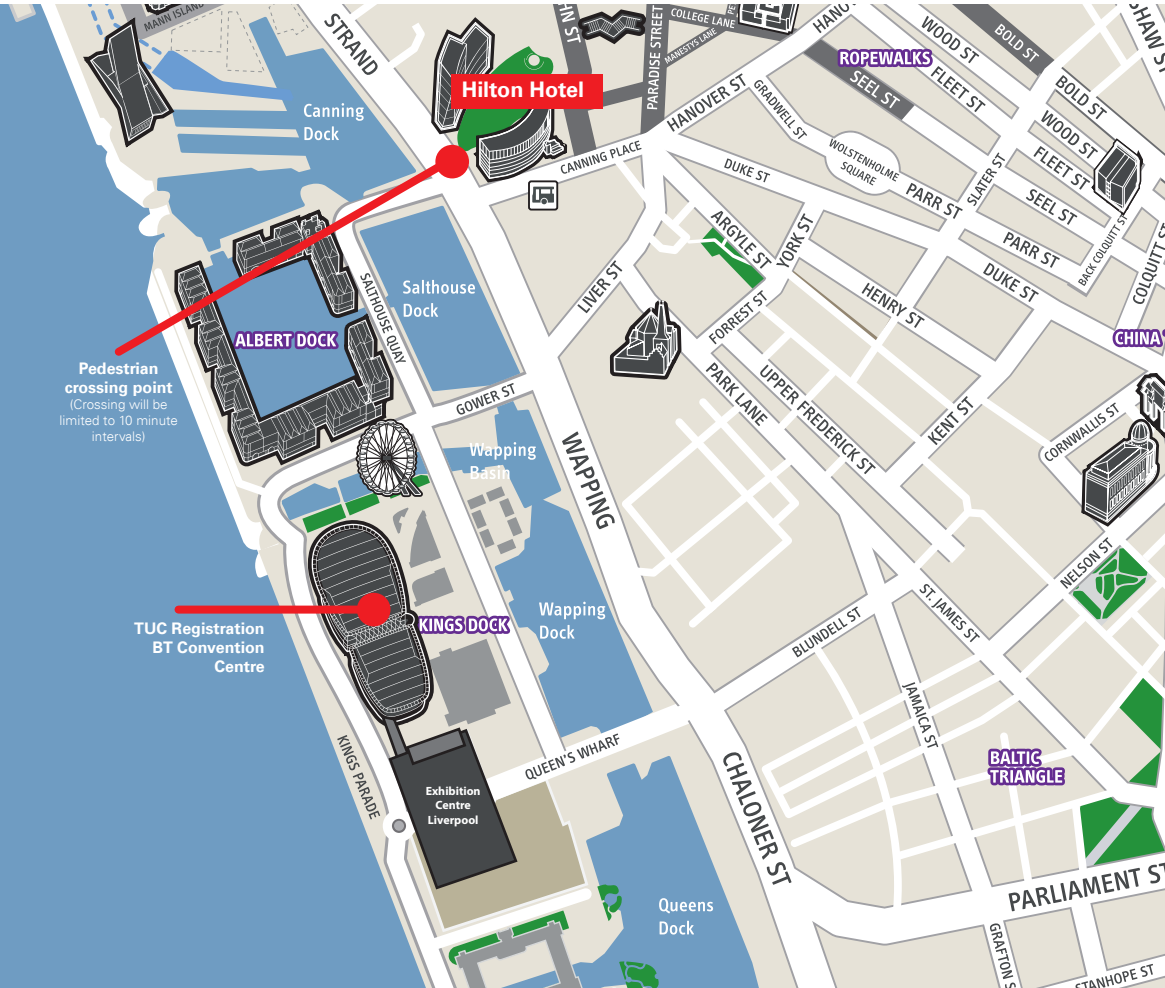

Exit M62 left onto Queens Drive A5080
Continue on Queens Drive (Childwall Fiveways roundabout)
