



LESE is the Trades Union Congress Regional Council for London, the East and South East of England. We represent TUC affiliated trade unions in the region.

We represent the interests of unions' two million members who live and work in our region and we work on behalf of all working people and their families.

The Regional Council has delegates from all unions that are affiliated to the Trades Union Congress and from the County Associations of Trades Councils within London, the East and South East of England.

Unions and trades councils nominate delegates to the Regional Council, which meets quarterly to discuss how to promote and achieve policy determined at the annual national Trade Union Congress and to make policy itself on issues in our regions.

The Regional office services the Regional Council, supports affiliates, represents the TUC in relations with public bodies and campaigns for Congress policy.

We have a range of Specialist Advisory Sub Groups that are based either upon industries or sectors, such as our Creative and Leisure Industries Committee, or upon equality strands, such as our committees for Race Relations, Women's Rights, Disabled Workers, LGBT workers, as well as a Pensioners committee and a Young Members network. We also have an International Committee.
