May Day at Hastings 2017


Come and Celebrate the International Day of Workers' Solidarity at Hastings on Monday 1st May 2017

Time table

- 2.00 2.30pm Speeches & Music at Harold Place, then at 2.30pm
- 2.30 March moves off in an Easterly direction, down Wellington Place as far as Sports Direct (where we have so often demonstrated). Then (before the Tunnel) turns along front of Pound Stretcher shop. There forms up in column again (if required), then marches Left onto Albert Road down to Queens Road. At Queens Road turn Left back to Harold Place, then down Robertson Street onto the Seafront Road to the Pier (Arriving at approx. 3.00pm) then to the End of the Pier for speeches and music to 4.00pm.
