





Carbon Revenue Forecast




Total revenue between 2013 and 2027 is £64bn (£11bn CPS)

Grant	Capital costs	Annual energy bill before measures	Annual energy bill after measures
£9,000	£9,000	£1,780	£1,150

Annual bill saving	% bill saving	CO2 saving
£630	35%	27%
